-Reading: The 2016-17 5th grade cohort will increase the percent proficient from 62% in 2015-16 to 80%(4 plus 2 more) based on the reading assessment of the Iowa Tests.

-Math: The 2016-17 7th grade cohort will increase the percent proficient from 54% in 2015-16 to 78% (7 plus 1) based on the mathematics assessment of the Iowa Tests.

-Science: The 2016-17 8th grade cohort will increase the percent proficient from 80% in 2015-16 to 90% based on the science assessment of the Iowa Tests.
