SPECIAL MEETING MARCH 24, 2014

The Board of Directors of the Edgewood-Colesburg Community School District met in the Edgewood Board Room, on Monday, March 24, 2014. President Randall Mescher called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Director Faust moved to ratify a two-year master contract with the Classified Association. The first year they will receive a 30 cent increase on the base or \$30.00 per month for the bus drivers. In addition, bus drivers extra miles beyond 52 will increase to \$12.75 per mile per month and shuttles will increase by 50 cents by day. This increase is 3.37%.
