ISASP Testing

Our 3rd through 6th grade students will begin taking the ISASP tests during the week of April 15th and 22nd. The schedule for testing days are listed in the Upcoming Dates section. We plan to have the students test during the first hour of each day. So it is really important that your child be on time for school. Students can become anxious during these tests, so here are a few ways to help your child to do their best.

- 1. Make sure your child is well rested. Getting enough sleep will help them to be focused during
