BUS USAGE BY NONRESIDENT OR PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS

Code No. 711.6

Subject to the prior claim of resident students, any student not residing in the district but accepted on a tuition basis, or any student attending a private school, may be transported on a district bus over a regularly established bus route, provided prior approval is obtained from the superintendent of schools. This approval may be withdrawn should the granting of bus privileges to nonresident students cause an overload on a bus. The secretary will bill the sending district, or the parents, once a year on the basis of actual cost. (The actual cost will be calculated on the basis of the average per-student cost of transportation for the preceding year.)

Students who qualify under the school district's policy on the admission of nonresident students are not required to pay transportation costs. (see Code No. 501.2)
