

Notes from the Nurse: From Tangee Salls

COVID-19:

- caused by novel coronavirus SARS-CoV-2
- Symptoms appear anywhere from 2-14 days after an exposure
- Spreads more quickly-more contagious
- Severe illness more often associated

Flu:

- Caused by Influenza A and B viruses
- Symptoms appear 1-4 days from exposure
- Antivirals are available
- A vaccine is currently available

Symptoms of both:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- Fatique
- Sore Throat
- Runny nose/congestion
- Muscle Aches
- Headache
- Nausea/vomiting

Prevention for Both:

- Avoid large events and mass gatherings
- Avoid close contact with those around you
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol based sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol
- Wear an appropriate mask
- Still cover a cough or sneeze with your elbow or a tissue and immediately wash your hands
- Avoid touching your face, especially your eyes, nose and mouth
- Clean and disinfect high-touch surfaces, such as doorknobs, light switches, electronics and counters.

If we continue with the measures that we have had in place and stay diligent, hopefully we will all stay healthy.
