English: a 1" binder, writing utensils, and a notebook (composition or spiral)

**Social Studies:** 1" binder just for social studies

**Reading:** a 1" binder and writing utensils

Science: 1" binder just for science, loose-leaf paper

History: 1" binder just for history, loose-leaf paper

**Computer:** set of ear buds or headphones for listening to lessons

**Agriculture:** 1" binder

Algebra: scientific calculator other than your phone, 1" binder

## 9th Grade -12th Grade

Accounting: an external 10-key keypad \*\*highly recommended

**Geometry:** scientific calculator other than your phone, 1" binder, compass, protractor

Algebra I: notebook, a 1" binder, scientific calculator, graph paper, book cover

Algebra II and higher: graphing calculator recommended (TI-83/TI 84), 1½ "binder and paper

**U.S. History:** notebook and folder

**AP US History:** 3-ring binder

**Agriculture Classes:** 3-ring binder and notebook
