March Madness:

- 1. Before the conference, make sure you speak with your child about school and how things are going.
- 2. Prepare a list of questions you would like to discuss.
 - a. What are my child's strengths and weaknesses?
 - b. Is my child participating in class?
 - c. Is my child respectful to other kids and professionals in the building?
 - d. How can I help my child at home?
- 3. Make sure you ask for teachers to explain any information that you do not understand.
- 4. Remember you are a team and work together to develop a plan if one is needed.
- 5. Celebrate your child' successes with the teacher and with your child!
- 6. After the conference, discuss the meeting with your child.
