Dear Parents,

Another school year is fast approaching. This letter contains important information about our online registration process and the upcoming school year.

Please note the following:

Registration: Online registration is REQUIRED for ALL GRADES. You will need to log into the JMC Parent portal via our school website using your username and password. Once you are logged in, directions will guide you through the registration process. ***Online registration will be open beginning August 3rd.*** We recommend using a laptop or PC instead of a mobile device to complete this process. If you need your JMC Parent password, please contact either building secretary to get that information.

Fees: We strongly encourage you to pay fees online via JMC. Once you've completed the online registration process, directions will instruct you on how to proceed with payment. On the reverse side of this letter is a Fee Schedule so you can estimate your registration costs. You may also pay your fees by completing the enclosed form and mailing it into the school. ***If you are applying for free or reduced lunches, it is recommended that you wait until your status is determined before paying fees.***

The entire registration process can be completed at home, which we highly recommend. If you are, however, in need of technical assistance with online registration or access to computers, please contact the high school office to set up an appointment.

All **NEW** and returning students **MUST** register online and pay fees **BEFORE** school begins on **August 24th**.

Free/Reduced Lunch: The free/reduced lunch application can be completed online via the JMC Parent portal. See our website for more information or contact Barb in the District Office with questions. If you wish to complete a paper copy, the applications are available on our website. Families wanting to apply for these benefits need to complete the online application **OR** return the paper forms to the District Office, P.O. Box 315, Edgewood, IA as soon as possible.

8th-12th Grade Schedules: Schedules are available on JMC. If your student needs to make changes to their schedule, **please do so before school starts either via a phone call or email to Mrs. Trenkamp.** She will respond to emails and return calls as quickly as she is able. NO CHANGES will be made after Friday, August 21, 2026.

JH/HS Laptops: If you have completed the laptop agreement and paid the one-time refundable deposit in a previous school year, you do **not** need to do so again. Both the completed agreement and a one-time **\$90 refundable deposit** are required to take the laptop home. The laptop loan agreement can be found on our website.

7th Grade & New Student Orientation: Orientation will be **Wednesday, August 19th at 6PM** in the commons. Students will receive their schedules. **A parent or legal guardian is required to attend.**

Elementary Open House: Open House for Preschool-6th grade will be on **Wednesday, August 19th from 4PM to 6PM.** Families may stop into classrooms during this time to greet your teachers and put away supplies. Preschool teachers will be contacting families to arrange home visits.

School Supply Lists: Supply lists can be found on our website: right hand side under "QuickLinks". They have been provided to the Manchester Wal-Mart.

School: School begins on Monday, August 24th for Grades JK-12. Preschool will begin on **Wednesday, August 26th.** **The school day will start at 8:15am and end at 3:15pm.**

School Pictures: Secondary pictures will be **Wednesday, September 23rd.** Elementary pictures will be **Thursday, September 24th.**

Email: Please be sure we have a current email address on file for your family. This allows us to communicate important information to families in a timely manner. Progress reports and report cards for JH/HS students are sent to parents via e-mail. The newsletter is also e-mailed each month to those families for which we have e-mail addresses.

Booster Club and Friends of the Arts: Membership forms are available on our school website under the Community/Boosters tab and in the High School office.

Required Health Documentation

7th-12th grade student athletes: Participants in athletics must have a current physical and concussion form on file in the HS office before the first day of practice. All forms must be updated/renewed annually.

Kindergarten & 3rd grade students: All students entering Kindergarten and 3rd grade are mandated to have a vision screening within one year prior to and no later than 6 months after entering those grades.

Kindergarten & 9th grade students: All students entering Kindergarten and 9th grade are mandated to have a dental screening within one year prior to entering those grades.

7th grade students: All students entering 7th grade are required to have proof of Tdap vaccine administration before the school year.

7th & 12th grade students: All students entering, advancing or transferring into 7th grade and born after September 15, 2004, will need proof of one dose of meningitis vaccine. All students entering, advancing, or transferring into 12th grade and born after September 15, 1999, will need proof of two doses of meningitis vaccine; or 1 dose if received when the student was 16 years of age or older. Proof of this vaccine will need to be provided **PRIOR** to the start of the first day of school.

Immunizations: All students should have up to date immunizations. If you are unsure if your child is up to date, please contact your healthcare provider. Exemptions from the immunization requirement in this policy will be allowed only for medical or religious reasons recognized under the law. The student must provide a valid Iowa State Department of Health Certificate of Immunization Exemption to be exempt from this policy.

Students who need to take medication at school: Any student taking prescription medication at school, including an inhaler, must have a form filled out and on file at the school. Students using an inhaler at school must have the form filled out by their doctor. A new form is required each school year.
